Oxydendron arboreum	-	Sourwood
Populus sp.	-	Poplar
Pyrus c. 'Bradford'	-	Bradford Pear, all other cultivars acceptable.
Quercus palustris	-	Pin Oak
Robinia sp.	-	Blacklocust
<u>Salix babylonica sp.</u>	-	<u>Babylon Weeping Willow</u>
Tsuga canadensis	-	Canadian Hemlock, unless in a very protected site.
