Meeting Updates	<p>Communications Planning meetings have been held on a bi-weekly basis with representatives from Transportation & Parking, Academic Affairs, Student Affairs, and The Blackwell. Topics include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Development of distribution lists for various project communications, including university neighbors - this will be discussed at the next Stakeholder's Meeting. • Important issues-based communications such as traffic / parking, pedestrian, noise, planned outages have been discussed. <p>Preconstruction meetings and Partnering meetings will be held in early May for both projects.</p>
Next update	<p>We anticipate issuing the next update in late-May.</p>
Project Status Report	<p>SAS / LAPG: The Early Site Electric project duct banks are complete. The conductors are installed and energized. Power change over at JONRC was completed on Friday, April 18. Pavement patching will begin in the next few weeks, as asphalt plants reopen for the season.</p> <p>The contracting process is underway for all bid packages in both projects.</p> <p>The existing lot on the corner of Lane Avenue and Tuttle Park Place will permanently close on Monday, April 28. Site fencing, mobilization, and demolition will begin immediately.</p> <p>Utilities Enabling Project: This project currently remains in design and is on track for bidding and award of contracts in late summer or early fall.</p>
